

Reminders:

Weather

RHE

In RHE during the first week back, we will be completing lesson 4, from Module 2, Unit 4 titled *People Who Help Us*. Children will learn what an emergency is and discuss which emergency service they might need in specific scenarios. Children will also discuss the principle of emergency and non-emergency First Aid.

Reading	Phonics
Please read with your child at least 5x over the week. Record any books they read (from school or home) in their reading diary.	Please help your child to practice the sounds they have learnt this week by completing their group's task.

<p>Phonics bingo - create bingo boards with words on.</p>	<p>Word hunt - hide words around your house or garden for children to find and read.</p>	<p>Phonics snap - make some snap cards with sounds or words on and play with a partner.</p>
<p>Sound hunt - say a sound and see if your child can find an object at home that starts with that sound.</p>	<p>Write and draw - write a word and see if your child can draw a picture of what you have written. Take it in turns.</p>	<p>I spy - Fred talk a word such as t-e-dd-y and see if your child can blend the word and find it.</p>
<p>Play the ghost game - the children love this one so much, I am sure they will teach the whole family!</p>	<p>Playdough words - give your child a word and see if they can make the letters with playdough.</p>	<p>Word walk - use some chalk to write words on the ground outside. See if your child can hop/jump/step across the word and say each sound as they land on it and then blend it when they get to the end.</p>
