

Early Mathematics

Children's Mental Health Week

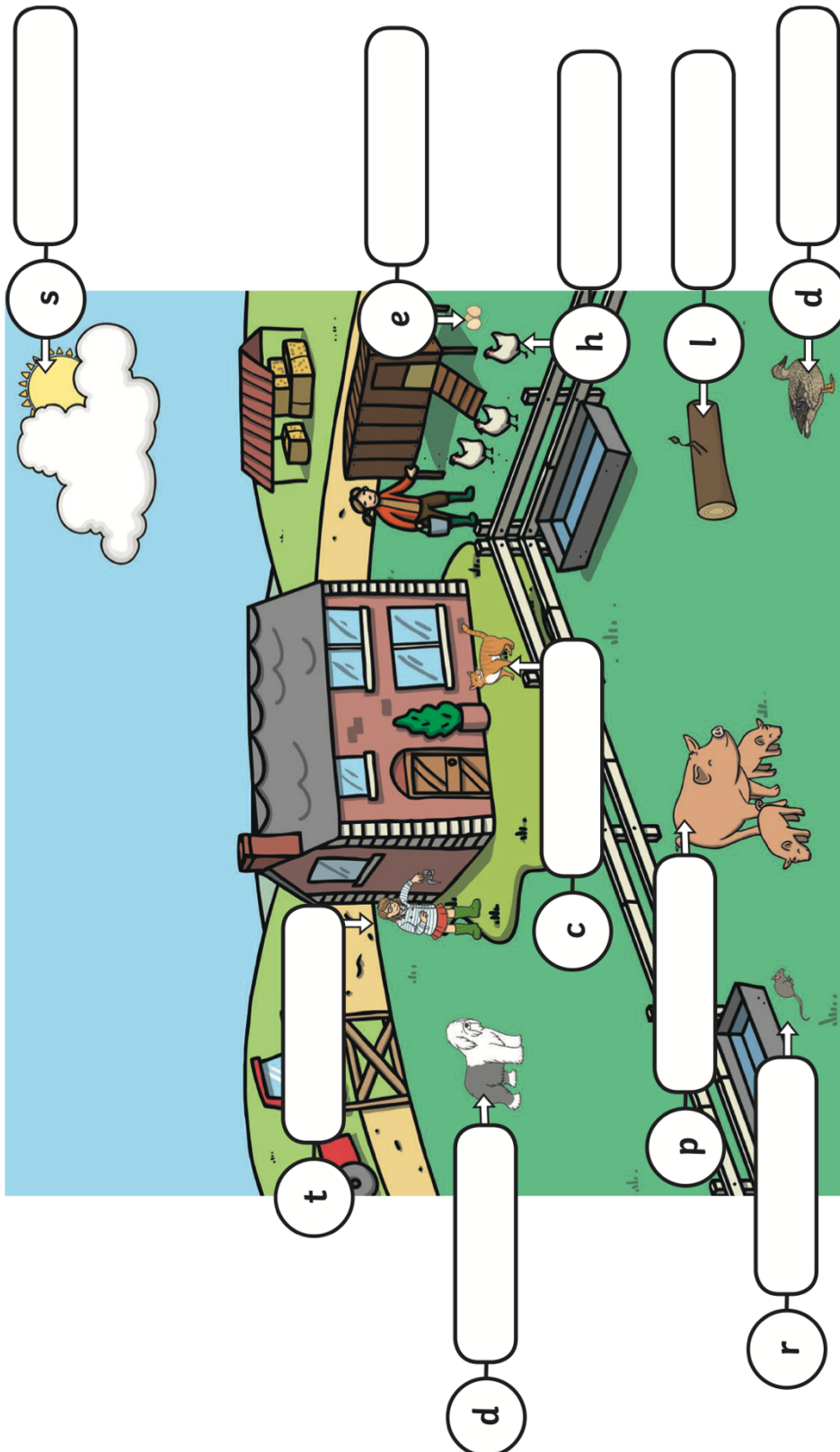
