# Topic and Links to Subject Areas:

Famous People

History - exploring and researching the lives and influences of famous historical figures Art - exploring famous artists and analysing Andy Warhol's artist techniques to create own picture of chosen historical or famous figure.

Literacy - reading, analysing and identifying techniques used in biography writing. Children to research famous person of choice and write biographies for them.

Maths - using statistics to provide details about lives of chosen famous person.

### Sparkling Start:

Inspirational people - children to think about who inspires them and to do short presentation on who inspires them and why.

#### Fabulous Finish:

Children to create booklets on chosen famous person with Andy Warhol style art work and their biographies about this person.
