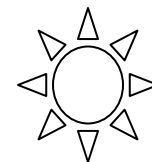


# Parents in Partnership

## English:

Following on from last week, this week we have been writing a character description of either Olive or Cliff from the 'Letters from the Lighthouse'. This has included using adjectives and noun phrases. It has also included using subordinate clauses to add extra detail.

Spellings: This week we have learnt about homophones and near homophones.

## Maths:

In maths this week, we have been consolidating our knowledge of addition and subtraction using worded number problems. Not only have the children had to solve the problems, but they have also had to explain how they got the answer. This has sometimes shown where they have made mistakes and has made them read the questions very carefully.

## Homework Tasks.

### This is a 2 week task.

Find out as much as you can about Air Raid Precautions during World War II. This could include information about how you knew an air raid was about to happen, what to do in an air raid, where you might shelter, what people did during an air raid, what happened afterwards. You might also want to find out about different air raid shelters - how big they were, where they were put, how they were built etc.

Present your work in an interesting way. You might want to make a model, a poster, a booklet or leaflet.
