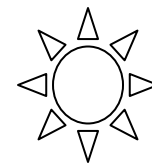


Parents in Partnership

This week we have been learning:-

English: We have been finding out about the characters of Olive and Cliff from 'Letters from the Lighthouse'. We have read the first chapter and made notes about them. We have also learnt how to write expanded noun phrases using a determiner (a or the), adjectives and then the noun.

Spellings: This week's spelling pattern has been a 'y' in the place of the long 'i' sound as in apply and occupy.

Maths: In maths, we have been using the skills of addition and subtraction in worded problems. They are very good at finding out the answers when they have worked out what to do.

Homework Tasks.

English:

Choose a character from a favourite fiction book. Write at least 5 expanded noun phrases about your character so that I can try to guess who it is. eg A huge, hairy man... A long, straggly beard... A dragon loving giant.... (Hagrid)
