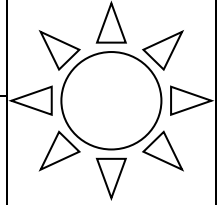


# Home Learning

Curl around the caterpillar

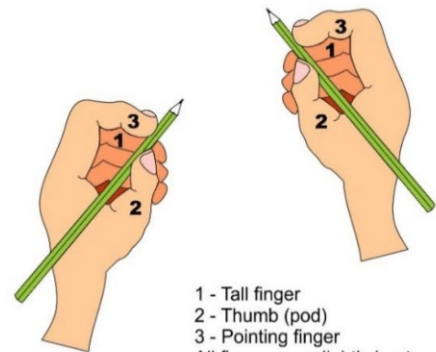
c c c c c
