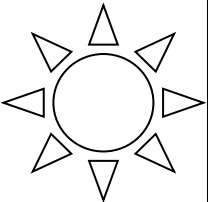

 I hope you have all managed to access Tapestry by now. If you haven't please let me know so we can get you set up on there as soon as possible so you don't miss any updates.

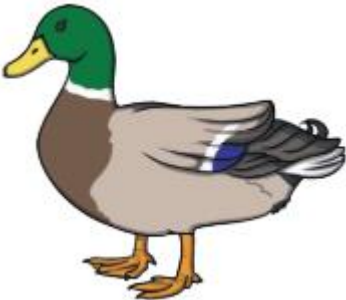
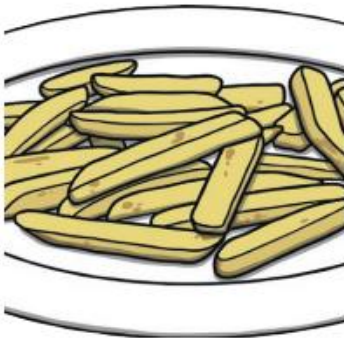
**PE**
