

- 3. The Y4 Statutory Multiplication Check will take place between 3rd and 14th June 2024. We will be increasing our multiplication practice in school over the coming half term. Supporting your child's fluency by practicing at home will support our practice in school. Some great resources and ways to support this:

 - d. Orally practicing tables both in and out of order.
 - e. Using and practicing multiplication in real world situations: whilst cooking/playing games/at the shops etc.
- 4. Our RHE in Summer 1 focuses on keeping safe. We build on our 'keeping safe online' sessions by thinking about how we stay safe in the real world. We will explore what is meant by the term abuse including sexual abuse which will be referred to as 'abuse of private parts'. We will also look at drugs, alcohol and tobacco and how these are bad for our bodies and how to make the right choices as we get older. The third session will explore 'first aid heroes' and look at why it's important to stay calm in an emergency and the final session will explore our rights and responsibilities and our role in a diverse world.
