Curriculum Topic Plan

Term: Autumn 2

Topic and Links to Subject Areas:

Refugee Crisis

Literacy - Reading 'A Story Like The Wind' - reading comprehension for term based on class text.
Literacy - diary writing - experiences of a refugee child, story writing about journey fleeing home.

Argument writing - discussion on how we could support refugees in Europe.

Poetry - Based on 'A Story Like The Wind' - writing poetry based on theme of being carried by the wind.

Maths - Distances travelled by refugees from home countries to safety. Ordering and comparing number up to and above 10,000,000 by ordering and comparing numbers of displaced people around the world.

Art/RE - Art work based on stories being carried by the wind.

Sparkling Start:

Refugee game - CAFOD activity where children have selection of items they choose to take with them on their journey. Children have to sacrifice belongings along the way to pay for transport, food, water etc in order to gain an understanding about what items are really important and how other children around the world have very different decisions to make.

Fabulous Finish:

End of term tea party for parents - children to present learning about fair trade and tea production and the refugee crisis to parents at end of term.

Children to share written letters and reports about child labour and fair trade and art work, diary writing and poetry with parents whilst serving tea and cake.
