




Q2) Regarding the Home Learning set during Lockdown, how did you feel the level of work was?




Q4) Was there anything your child really struggled with?


Q5) How do you feel your child managed with the return to school?





Q6) What is your current employment status?




Q7) As a result of Lockdown, have you or your partner suffered either a job loss or financial loss?




Q8) Have you noticed any changes in your child's behaviour?
