As a Governing Body we have tried to keep the school uniform practical and easily available for purchase. Thus it is hoped that the uniform will be affordable to parents.

Governors are aware that financial assistance may be sought from the school. A small budget to support such need may need to be allocated from the general school budget. The assessment of the need to call upon this fund will be the following criteria only:-

Any consideration of further support from the Governing Body may be available to parents whose children are in receipt of free school meals.

Authorised expenditure up to a maximum of £35 per child can be accessed every 2 years - for items of clothing which are only school specific i.e not shoes nor coats
