

Reading	Times Table Rock Stars	Spellings/Phonics
Please read at least 5x over the week. Please remember to write in their reading journals so we can count their reads. Remember that in their daily phonics lessons the children participate in reading activities.	As detailed above, you have access to times table rockstars. Have fun working on counting in 10s and the 10 times table. To help your child with the games online, when children are presented with 2X10 for example, you could ask your child to count in 10s, perhaps presenting them with 2 wooden blocks or drawing 2 long lines to represent 10. The children are very experienced in counting in 10s. Have fun.	This week, the children who have purple RWI reading books have started learning the Set 3 Sounds detailed overleaf.Please revisit all Set 2 sounds and the Set 3 sounds if your child has a purple, orange or yellow RWI book. If your child has a green RWI book please continue to focus on the Set 2 sounds. Thank you.
