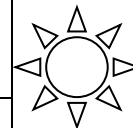

Times Tables Rock Stars is a maths programme that takes all the worry out of learning times tables and has a proven track record of boosting children's fluency and recall in multiplication and division.

When you enter the site, you will be asked for the school name or postcode. Our Postcode is DT4 ORH.(That's a zero.)

From here you then enter the username and password and your child will have access to fun games involving the 10s and 5 times tables.

In reception the children learned to count in 10s and 5s, and we will be continuing to work with them on this this year. Please help your child build their fluency by playing the games. I think they'll really enjoy it.






We thank you for recording every time you read with your child at home in their yellow book.
