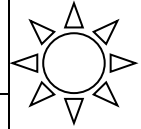

In preparation for next week we ask for your support...

1. On **Thursday 12th September**, please could you give your child a toy to bring in that they like to play with. The toys will be returned that day. We will use these toys to help us with our History work as we start to look at toys and during this unit of work, will compare them to toys our grandparents played with.
2. Our PE days this year are Wednesdays and Fridays. We ask that the children come to school in their PE Kits on these days. Thank you.
3. Please remember to send the reading record in and as from next week, we will continue to send home your child's reading books on a Wednesday. These books will include their Read, Write Inc. Book together with 2 reading for pleasure books for you to enjoy at home with your child.
4. On Monday 9th September in the Year 1 classroom after school, we ask you to collect your child as normal and then walk up to the main entrance of the school where we will invite you in for the 'Meet the Teacher' Meeting. This meeting will involve a Powerpoint Presentation which will detail some of the learning that your child will engage in during the coming year. After the meeting, the Presentation will be placed on the school website for you to revisit or to look at if you can't attend in person. Also, every week, you will receive a copy of the home learning letter and this too, will also be placed on the website. This ensures that you don't miss out on important class information.

In Relationships and Health Education next week, the children will learn that we are created individually by God and that we can give thanks to God in different ways.
