

- Reminders:
1. **Important:** Next week, your child will be bringing home a sound blending book on Wednesday. This is to support your child with practicing blending and reading words that they have practiced in class. Please encourage them to practice reading these and to do this regularly. These books need to be returned to school the following Wednesday (book change day) and then your child will be given a new book.
 2. **Missing or Lost Read, Write, Inc. Books:** As a School, we took the decision to invest a lot of money into a systematic phonics scheme to support every child with their early reading and writing. We understand that accidents do happen, and sometimes books are lost, but it is essential that any lost or damaged books be replaced. In such circumstances, please inform the School Office about the name of the book which has been lost/damaged and pay £5.00 to cover the cost of a replacement book.
 3. Please continue to record any reading your child does at home in their reading diaries.
 4. Next week, in **RHE** we will be completing the lesson *Let's Get Real*. This session moves away from Freddy Teddy and friends and looks at a real-life example of a challenging situation that pupils may face. Children will engage creatively with this story, learning that actions have consequences; that when we make mistakes, we should say sorry and ask for forgiveness. This will lead into a basic exploration of Jesus' forgiveness for us.
