

Please note that as well as providing an online book for your child, a quiz is also assigned to help develop your child's comprehension skills.


This week the children have continued to work so hard. In topic work their areas of learning have included identifying physical features in the local area, learning about the common and different characteristics of mammals, birds, fish, reptiles and amphibians and have been continuing to learn learning about algorithms in computing and have been very busy learning the songs for our Christmas Play. We have also had a visitor this week- Bobby Wilkinson- the Weymouth Football Manager. The children prepared some excellent questions to ask, including, What colour is your kit? How do you do a slide tackle? Can you bounce a ball on your foot? What colour ball do you use? It was a really interesting session and showed the interest our children have for football.

In Relationships and Health Education this half term we are continuing to learn about being special, unique and about being safe.

### **Home Learning Tasks**

Reading	Times Table Rock Stars	Spellings/Phonics
Please read at least 5x over the week. Please remember to write in their reading journals so we can count their reads. Remember that in their daily phonics lessons the children participate in reading activities.	As detailed above, you have access to times table rockstars. Have fun working on counting in 10s and the 10 times table. To help your child with the games online, when children are presented with 2X10 for example, you could ask your child to count in 10s, perhaps presenting them with 2 wooden blocks or drawing 2 long lines to represent 10. The children are very experienced in counting in 10s. Have fun.	The children who have purple RWI reading books have continued learning the Set 3 Sounds detailed overleaf. Please revisit all Set 2 sounds and the Set 3 sounds if your child has a purple, orange or yellow RWI book. If your child has a green RWI book please continue to focus on the Set 2 sounds. Thank you.
