It was a packed week where they...

- 1. taught 3 English lessons (gave a presentation about our school and Weymouth/Portland, read a story, hosted a question and answer session so pupils could practise their English).
- 2. visited a World War 2 German abandoned munitions factory, turned into a museum.
- 3. visited a museum all about the production of soap (and made their own!)
- 4. observed a speech and language therapy session and an ICT session about internet safety.

## Year 2 of the Project
