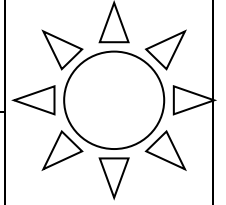

Sandwich Making

As part of our work in English we are learning about Instructions.

We are learning to write instructions on making jam sandwiches. On Tuesday, we will be making and eating Jam Sandwiches in the afternoon. Please let me know if you do not want your child to eat jam sandwiches. Thank you.

In Maths we have been learning about money.

We've been learning to recognise coins and notes and have also leared to count money amounts. Any practical money work you could do at home such as sorting coins or putting coin values in order or adding small amounts of money would be very beneficial.

In Geography we've continued our work on comparing rural and urbans areas in Kenya.

In Science we've been learning about characteristics of Autumn and have recapped our work on seasonal change.

Next week in PSHE and RHE we will be combing our work with our work on Neighbours in RE.

The children will learn:

- To know what a community is, and that God calls us to live in community with one another
- A scripture illustrating the importance of living in community.
- Jesus' teaching on neighbours,

In Geography we're comparing urban and rural areas and have been learning about Naro Maru in Kenya as a rural location and have been developing our knowledge of physical and human features.

In RE we have been considering how we can be good neighbours and how we can use our gospel values.

Next week in RHE/PSHE we will be continuing to work on how people help us.

The children will learn:

- To call 999 in an emergency and ask for ambulance, police and/or fire brigade
- That if they require medical help but it is not an emergency, basic First Aid should be used instead of calling 999
- Some basic principles of First Aid

<u>Reading</u>	<u>Times Table Rock Stars</u>	<u>Spellings/Phonics</u>
Please read at least 5x over the week. Please remember to write in their reading journals so we can count their reads. Remember that in their daily phonics lessons the children participate in reading activities.	Have fun working on counting in 10s and the 10 times table and on counting in 5s and the 5 times table. To help your child with the games online, when children are presented with 2X10 for example, you could ask your child to count in 10s, perhaps presenting them with 2 wooden blocks or drawing 2 long lines to represent 10. The children are very experienced in counting in 10s and also in 5s. Have fun.	The children who have purple RWI reading books have continued learning the Set 3 Sounds detailed below.
