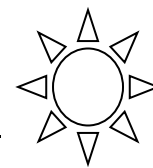


Parents in Partnership

This week we have been learning:-

English: We have been looking at different diaries and finding out their features.

Spellings: In preparation for a test at the end of term, we have been looking at the Year 5/6 spelling list. The children had to find out the meanings of any words they didn't understand and then practise spelling the words. They concentrated on the first 2 columns and paid attention to words with double letters, words with a silent letter and words with an unexpected letter - eg cemetery.

Maths: We have been learning how to add and subtract using decimals. In particular, we have looked at different decimal numbers that add up to 1.

Homework Tasks.

English:

Find a picture that interests you. Stick it in your book. Then show you friendly grown up how you can 'read' a picture.

Observe at least 10 different things, ask at least 5 'I wonder..' questions and write at least 5 'I infer...' sentences. Don't forget to use the word 'because' in the infer sentences.

Maths:

Using this layout, find at least 10 different ways to add decimals together to make 1.

Challenge yourself by using decimals with hundredths and thousandths.
