#### Read, Write Inc.

Just before Christmas the children completed their half-termly phonics assessments. They are making lots of great progress which we are very happy about. Based on this, children will be regrouped slightly next week. They will all still be working on learning set 1 sounds and reading and spelling these in words. We have put a speed sounds chart in their book bags to support them with recognizing the sounds and to use as a prompt for spelling at home. If you would like more information about this, we can give you a leaflet - please just ask! Please continue to work on practicing reading using the "book bag books" sent home and practice spelling through the homework tasks/during the children's play as they write things such as shopping lists, posters, letters etc.
