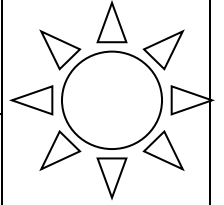

A Busy Week

The children have returned to school with a spring in their step and it's been a joy to see!

They have worked hard in many curriculum areas. Here is an update on some of their learning...

In Maths the children have been learning about positional language and ordinal numbers.

They have also been continuing to develop their number fluency through working on the 99 Club.

In RE, the children have been learning about God's Promise from the Book of Isaiah. They have thought about ways they can show their Gospel Values to others and 'let their lights shine.'

In Science, linked to work on seasonal change, the children have been learning about animals and hibernation. This has led to interesting discussions based on how animals prepare and why they hibernate. It's been so fascinating.

Phonics Screening

Next week the children will be participating in the statutory Year 1 Phonics Screening. This will involve them sitting with myself and reading 40 phonetically spelt words, some of which are real words and some of which are invented words in order for them to show that they can blend sounds to read accurately. I ask that in order to prepare your child, you look at the words attached to this sheet. Also, please go through the speed sounds overleaf and play the games referenced below.
