In our RHE unit over the next few weeks we will be looking at being safe in our bodies. Children will be introduced to the term 'abuse' and discuss different kinds of abuse. Animated expert Dr Datfa helps children to learn in greater depth about the effects of drugs, alcohol and tobacco and how to make good choices concerning these as they get older. Children will explore in more detail what to do in emergency situations. The final session of the module identifies legal rights and considers how our responsibilities relate to these. This is underpinned by the religious understanding that we all play a part in the Body of Christ.
