Sometimes in class we play phonics games. To help strengthen your child's reading skills you might like to look at these games available on:





Please read at least 5x over the week. Please remember to write in their reading journals so we can count their reads. Remember that in their daily phonics lessons the children participate in reading activities.	Have fun working on counting in 10s and the 10 times table and on counting in 5s and the 5 times table. To help your child with the games online, when children are presented with 2X10 for example, you could ask your child to count in 10s, perhaps presenting them with 2 wooden blocks or drawing 2 long lines to represent 10.
