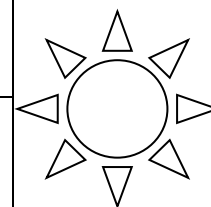

1. Please send reading records and reading books to school each day.
2. Once your child has finished their reading book, they can take the quiz or Accelerated Reader by following the link on the Year 4 home learning page on the school website and using the login details in the back of their reading journal.
