

**Weather**

<p><b>Phonics bingo</b> - create bingo boards with words on.</p>	<p><b>Word hunt</b> - hide words around your house or garden for children to find and read.</p>	<p><b>Phonics snap</b> - make some snap cards with sounds or words on and play with a partner.</p>
<p><b>Sound hunt</b> - say a sound and see if your child can find an object at home that starts with that sound.</p>	<p><b>Write and draw</b> - write a word and see if your child can draw a picture of what you have written. Take it in turns.</p>	<p><b>I spy</b> - Fred talk a word such as t-e-dd-y and see if your child can blend the word and find it.</p>
<p><b>Play the ghost game</b> - the children love this one so much, I am sure they will teach the whole family!</p>	<p><b>Playdough words</b> - give your child a word and see if they can make the letters with playdough.</p>	<p><b>Word walk</b> - use some chalk to write words on the ground outside. See if your child can hop/jump/step across the word and say each sound as they land on it and then blend it when they get to the end.</p>
