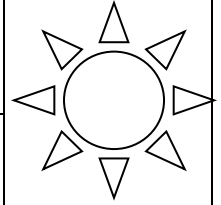

#### Well Done

The class have worked hard all week. Here's a quick summary of some of the learning that's been taking place...

In English, the children have written their own stories based on The Everywhere Bear. We're so proud of the way the children have remembered to use expressive language to make their stories so expressive!

In Maths we've been learning about fair sharing as a pre-cursor to division work and have working on practical halving to help them too.

In RE we're ending our unit on Holy Days and Holidays and have prepared our class worship which will take place next.

**In our RHE and PSHE we've continued to consider staying safe online and next week we will be working on a lesson called Good and Bad Secrets.**

**In this session, children will learn the difference between good secrets that are safe to keep, and bad secrets that are unsafe to keep. They will help Super Susie to decide whether some secrets she is asked to keep are good or bad, and what to do about it. Through activities and teaching, children will learn how to resist pressure when feeling unsafe.**
