Homework

- Homework books are due in every Thursday and will be sent out on Fridays.
- Your child will have weekly spellings to practise using the look, cover, write, check grids.
- Your child will have times tables to practise for a fortnightly test - 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Your child will also have a piece of homework linked to what we have been doing in either English, maths or topic.

Reading

- The expectation is that your child will read daily throughout their time in YEAR TWO.
- When your child has finished their reading book, they need to put it in the classroom box ready for changing.
- Please remember to sign and date the reading journal every time your child reads to you.
- Please also let us know which page your child has reached in their book, along with a comment on how they have got on with their reading.
- As the children develop their fluency, it is important to test their understanding of the book. At the front of the reading journal is a bookmark with some questions to ask your child about their book.

Behaviour Policy

- Across the school we use the GOOD TO BE GREEN behaviour charts.
- Each child begins the day with a GREEN card.
- If negative behaviour is shown, the child will be reminded, then will be issued with a YELLOW warning card.
- If negative behaviour persists, the child will be issued with a RED card and will be sent to another class for cooling down time. A letter will also be sent home.
- Children work together to gain house points, which are added up and recorded as part of a whole school assembly each Friday.
- In Year Two we have a marble jar to reward the class when they have shown that they can work together as a class team (e.g. lining up at playtime nicely). When the marble jar is full, the children will vote on a class treat!

How you can help:

- Please label all of your child's belongings including PE kits and outdoor clothing.
- If your child is unfit for P.E. please write a letter with the reason.
- Please ensure that your child hands in their homework each week by Thursday.
- Please ensure bookbags and reading books/journals are in school every day.
- Please listen to your child read daily and fill in their reading journal.
- Please make an appointment to see one of us if you have any concerns about your child.
