#### **Relationships and Health Education**

Next week in RHE we will be starting a unit of work called Keeping Safe. Session 1 is called 'Good and Bad Secrets.' In this session, the children will learn the difference between good secrets that are safe to keep, and bad secrets that are unsafe to keep. They will help' Super Susie' to decide whether some secrets she is asked to keep are good or bad, and what to do about it. Through activities and teaching, children will learn how to resist pressure when feeling unsafe.

#### **Oxford Reading Owl Books**

Every week we will continue to assign an online book (that is in line with their daily reading in school and you will be able to help your child read it and access online questions to check comprehension. We ask that you write in your child's reading record when you have shared the online book at home. We hope you and your child enjoy this extra excellent reading resource.

This book is directly linked to your child's reading stage and is a home book that strengthens and reinforces the reading material your child accesses in their daily phonic lessons.






