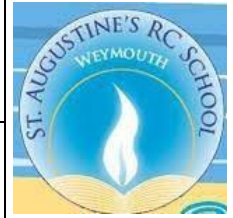


Home Learning

In History, we rounded off our Stone age unit and thought about what changed in Britain from Stone Age to Iron Age. We played some great games of netball this week, the children have worked hard on their attacking and defending skills, shooting and ensuring they do not move with the ball. In art, we used charcoal to draw stone age animals on top of the backgrounds we had previously painted. We completed an experiment in science where we looked at the size of a shadow when you move the sources of light. We really enjoyed this!
