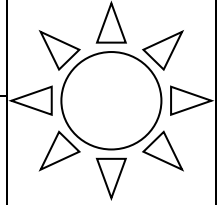

In RHE after half term the first lesson back is the four types of abuse. The first week back we will be doing Module 2 Unit 4 - Types of Abuse

This session follows on from the previous two internet safety sessions, by moving into the real world and considering what physical contact is appropriate and inappropriate. Through 4 fictional stories, children will be introduced to the term 'abuse' and discuss the different kinds of abuse, including sexual (which in LKS2 was described as 'abuse of private parts'). Children will be introduced to the concept of rights, and how abuse violates their rights. They will be asked to think of trusted adults that they can talk to about any issues they may face.

We will NOT be doing the optional FGM section so it will be version 1.
