Have fun working on counting in 10s and the 10 times table. To help your child with the games online, when children are presented with 2X10 for example, you could ask your child to count in 10s, perhaps presenting them with 2 wooden blocks or drawing 2 long lines to represent 10. The children are very experienced in counting in 10s. Have fun.	Every week we will detail the sounds the children have been recapping or have been introduced to during their phonics lessons. Please see the sounds we have focused on this week and once your child has read them with you, dictate a simple sentence for them to write containing some of the words listed and also ask them to practice handwriting the words.
