The Y4 Multiplication Check takes place towards the end of Year 4.

When will 'The Multiplication Check' take place?

In 2025, schools must administer the MTC to all eligible year 4 pupils from Monday 2 June for a 2 week period.

# Multiplication Check - Guidance for parents

We will use either the school I pads or chromebooks to carry out the Check.

The children will have practised beforehand on the device that they will use and they will be used to the format of the MTC.

At the end of the assessment window, a total score out of 25 will be reported to each school for all of their pupils who took the check.

There is no expected standard threshold for the MTC.
