This week we have been learning:-

<u>English:</u> We have been looking at how adverts persuade people to buy products. We have found out about modal verbs which are used to show how likely something is to happen. Ask your child what these verbs are.

<u>Spellings:</u> We have been learning the spelling pattern 'ough'. 'Ough' can make many sounds for example 'ow', 'or' and 'uff'

Maths: We have been looking at charts and tables and gathering information from them.

Homework Tasks.

English:

Explain to a friendly grown up what modal verbs are. Can you remember all 10 of them (clue: will, might, ought to.). Write at least 5 sentences about your weekend using modal verbs. For example - I should have gone to the gym but it was too cold.

Make sure that you use correct punctuation and check your spellings carefully.

Tell your friendly grown up the 8 different sounds for 'ough'. Can you remember all of them?

Maths:

Find a TV programme schedule. You might find one in a newspaper or magazine or online. What are your 3 favourite TV programmes? Find the start and end time of these 3 programmes. Write them down and then work out how long each programme lasts. If the time is written in the 24hr clock, then transfer it to the 12 hour clock. And if it is in the 12 hour clock transfer it to the 24 hour clock.
