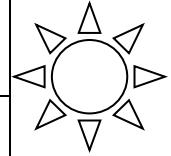

Times Tables Rock Stars is a maths programme that takes all the worry out of learning times tables and has a proven track record of boosting children's fluency and recall in multiplication and division.

When you enter the site, you will be asked for the school name or postcode. Our Postcode is DT4 0RH.(That's a zero.)

From here you then enter the username and password and your child will have access to fun games involving the 10s and 5 times tables.

Handwriting

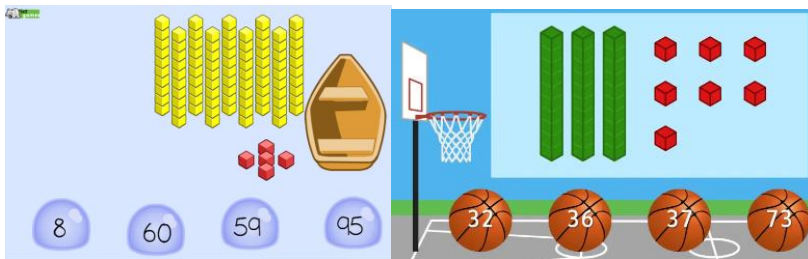
To help support your child with their handwriting please use the rhymes from Read Write Inc. As shown on the next page.
